Kohl Glass is an American film and television director, and screenwriter, known for his strong, visual style and creative originality. An incredibly versatile filmmaker, Kohl's sensibilities span from dark psychological films like his shorts *The Promethean* and *Der Ostwind* (Official Selection of the Sundance Film Festival), to slightly comedic action fantasies, like his first feature *Orc Wars* (a.k.a *Dragonfyre*), to fairytales like *Eugenie* and *The Fisherman and His Wife*, both of which he directed for BYU Broadcasting. Kohl directed his second feature, a thriller for MarVista Entertainment, which premiered on Lifetime June 4th, 2016 under the title *You May Now Kill the Bride*.

Kohl has also written several screenplays, among which is the dark comedy *The Great Hellpike of Steelwell Pond*, which was optioned by Greasy Entertainment. In 2012, *The Generations Project* episode "Natalie," which Kohl wrote, won an Emmy. More recently he has written scripts for Avalanche Studios, Candlelight Media, Excel Entertainment, and for producer Trevor Stewart.

Originally from Arizona, raised in Colorado, Kohl currently lives in Salt Lake City, Utah with his wife and daughter.
